Update - We still haven't received the correct reports from Moxie since we started working with them in July. Rosamaria has sent them an email requesting them to produce the correct spreadsheets that was requested. The Board will need approve the Budget and P&L from July 2022 to October 2022 once corrected.

• Presidents Items for Review:

Sponsor Matrix – Update – Discussion regarding option for monthly payment for bronze sponsorship. On the Table Bronze sponsor monthly fee \$25 for plug-in with Paypal. They charge \$225 annually for this monthly payment plug-in. Deciding to tack on \$225 annual fee / \$25 Monthly / Admin fee both would be a one-time fee to each monthly payment sponsor. Payments would be set for automatic payments only.

Two options

- 1. Annual Fee \$225.00 one-time fee
- 2. Monthly Fee / Admin Fee \$25.00 one-time fee



More discussion on how the fee will work, it is easier for Bronze (mainly Brokers) sponsors to pay a monthly fee vs a full annual fee. This will only be offered to the Bronze Sponsors.
